Background:

Since the beginning of the transformation process, Herold Engineering was engaged as a consulting engineer on the design of the new marina. They were chosen in Early 2018 through a Request for Proposal process. Their contract was scoped at a cost of \$228 000 and has been increased once in order to plan for additional Environmental Surveys. The current CER for Design work sits capped at \$266 782. New work includes \$18 000 contingency to produce an Environmental Offset Plan.
