Project update from Juno Beach and Dunkirk

After a successful splash of the boats on Wednesday Feb 23, we are now ready to receive the newly painted Stevedore barges on the main dock. Thank you to Patrol Craft Training Unit for priming and painting the barges over the past week. QHM will deliver the barges this Friday, Feb 25 and be placed on the main dock to prepare for loading. Thank you to the launch crew for getting the boats back in the water and clearing space on the hard as we move forward onshore work.

Last week, LB Crane assessed and provided instructions in preparation for crane lifts onto stevedore barges and the Oriole Workshop dock. Details are now being planned/completed to meet these lift requirements. As these details are developed we are also finalizing plans for moving items to storage.

We are receiving bids for the placement of the rock anchors and continuing discussions with QHM on the placement plan for the clumps which we expect to arrive between March 1 - 4. In the coming week, we will be finalizing the design and plan for dock bridles. Overall, we are feeling confident with planning, timelines and expect to hear final approval on the CER as early as this week and are on track with DFO approval.
